The Blood and The Body The Wine and The Bread

This Month's Message by Ronnie Christian

John 6:54 "He who eats my flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."

Communion: in this word is the word "union". God wants to have union with His people. It is as if He is saying, "Come into union with Me." When two water pipes are joined (fitted) together, it is a joining; it makes a joint, it is also called a union. We, the Church, are the bride of Christ; marriage is a union.

THE IMPORTANCE OF THE BLOOD: The 1st bloodshed written about in the Bible was for mankind. The story is in Genesis 3 about Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. This was man's first sin. The man and the woman tried to cover their own sin. They had been naked but now they sewed fig leaves together to cover themselves and to cover their sin. (Gen. 3:7) **Not good enough!** It required a sacrifice, <u>the innocent for the guilty.</u>

Genesis 3:21 "Also for Adam and his wife the Lord God made a tunic of skin, and clothed them." It took blood to cover their sin. God killed an innocent animal as a sacrifice and made clothes for Adam and Eve. This was a foreshadow of what was to come through Jesus. This was a type and shadow of Jesus who was to shed His Blood and die for the forgiveness of our sin. The innocent for the guilty!

Move forward from Adam and Eve to Moses in Exodus 12 to Passover Night. This was the night before Moses led the people out of slavery in Egypt. God passed through the land and killed every firstborn child and beast in all of Egypt except one group of people. *Exodus 11:7 "But against none* of the children of Israel; man or beast that you may know that the Lord makes a difference between the Egyptians and Israel..." On Judgment Day, God will show the difference between those who received His Son, Jesus, and those who did not. John 3:36 says, "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but wrath of God abides in him."

In Exodus 12 God instructed Moses and Aaron to tell the people to take an unblemished lamb, kill it, put the blood on the doorposts and lintel. This was a foreshadow of the blood

and the cross of Jesus. It was put on the top and two sides of the door. Then, they were to boil the lamb and eat it. *Exodus 12:13 "Now the blood shall be a sign for you; And when I see the blood I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt." Vs. 29 shows at midnight the Lord struck all the firstborn of Egypt. The Israelites were saved from the plague of death. This is a type and shadow of what Jesus would mean for us. When God sees the Blood of Jesus applied to our hearts He will pass over and we will not be condemned to eternal death, but will be given eternal life.*

A blood covenant is the strongest covenant on the earth.

ourselves, our children, our homes. The Blood of Jesus is protection for us now from the enemy who wants to destroy us. Plead the Blood of Jesus over your family. People who have pled the Blood over their children have gotten reports of them walking away from train wrecks, while the others died. Would be rape victims pleaded the Blood and chased the perpetrators away.

The Bread: Also remember, they ate the lamb. This was the first Passover meal but God instructed them in Exodus 12 to take this meal every year as a reminder of God,s deliverance. Each year the High Priest would take the blood of an unblemished lamb into the Most Holy Place (Holy of Holies) in the tabernacle, and years later into the temple, for the sins of the whole nation of Israel. It would push their sins back for another year and they would repeat this again. However, when Jesus came John said, "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world." (John 1:29) He does not just cover us - He washes our sins away.

In the New Testament: Jesus had His last Passover Meal with His disciples, the night He was betrayed. The Israelites had been having Passover meal for 1400 years. However this year Jesus was to become our Passover Lamb.The whole Passover meal points to Jesus: <u>His death-our deliverance</u>. *Matthew 26:26 says "And while they were eating, Jesus took some bread, and after a blessing, He broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, 'Take eat; this is my body.' (Vs. 27) And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them saying, 'Drink from it, all of you; (Vs. 28) for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.'"*

John 6:47 reports it this way, "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life. (Vs. 48) I am the bread of life." (Vs. 51) "I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever; and the bread also which I shall give for the life of the world is My flesh." In Vs. 53 "Jesus therefore, said unto them, 'Truly, truly I say to you unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood you have no life in yourselves."" (Vs. 55) "For My flesh is true food, and My blood is true drink. (Vs. 56) He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him."

When you take the Lord's Supper (Communion) 1 Corinthians 11:28-29: instructs us to examine the body. Examine your body, examine the body of Jesus, and examine the body of Christ, the church. We are instructed not to partake in an unworthy manner. Many are sick and even died by doing this. The Spirit-Filled Life Study Bible NKJ comments on this as follows, To partake in a "worthy" manner is to attribute the full worth of Christ's redeeming work to this action-to partake with faith in His full forgiveness, full acceptance, and full power to restore, strengthen, and heal.

The Blood of Jesus is sufficient to forgive every sin, deliver us from

every evil, keep us alive and in good health, and bring us to heaven.

Some believe we are just remembering Him. However, others teach "consubstantiation" with which I agree, that He is present at communion. Surely since He is present where two or three gather in His name, He is present at communion. He wants to meet with us, fellowship with us, forgive us, give us peace, set us free, deliver us from evil, and instruct us.

Isaiah 53 and 1 Peter 2:24-25 shows that He died to give us these things.

The next time you receive the bread and wine (or grape juice) at communion receive all that Jesus did for you - physically, spiritually, emotionally, financially, socially, eternally.

The Only Way to the Father: John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me. (Vs. 7) If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also..." This is the only way to Heaven. To receive eternal life, receive Jesus. Pray this, I am a sinner. I need a Savior. Thank you Jesus for shedding your blood on the cross for my forgiveness, for dying for me, for giving your body. I receive you now as my Savior and Lord. I plead the blood of Jesus over my mind, my heart, and my life. Holy Spirit help me to live a life pleasing to my Father in heaven. In Jesus Name Amen. Read (Romans 3:10; 3:23; 5:8-9; 6:23; 10:9-10, 13; John 3:16; Luke 11:13; Acts 1:8; Acts 2:38). Read the Bible daily, pray daily, get water baptized, ask Jesus to baptize you in the Holy Spirit, meet often with other believers.

P.S. Begin to plead the Blood of Jesus and apply the Blood of Jesus over yourself, your family, animals, house, possessions, for protection -in Jesus Name.The Blood is sufficient to protect and save us.

Go into all the world: That is what Jesus said to do. As you send us with finances, prayers and help us, we go as instructed and present Jesus as Lord to a lost and dying world. Many are saved, healed, and restored. Be a Cowboy Partner with us-you will share in every soul we reach.

You can have holy sex or you can have unholy sex. You can have sex and sin -or- you can have sex and be righteous.

God designed sex and He is all for it. When you do it His way He says something like "All right, go for it, enjoy" but when you don't do it His way, it's a no, no - it's sin and He cannot bless it.

What is His way? Sex is to be in the bonds of marriage only between a man and a woman. The Bible clearly states that sex outside of marriage is a sin whether it is fornication, adultery or homosexuality. Fornication is sex outside of marriage, adultery is sex with someone other than your spouse or sex with som one else's spouse, homosexuality is sex between two males or two females. You can rationalize it all you want to but the Bible, God's word, calls it sin. No excuse is acceptable.

This article is to warn and help you, not to condemn. The sin is already condemned. But Jesus did not come to condemn you. He came to save you (John 3:17) and get you out of your mess and get you into a right relationship with God, the Father. The Bible clearly states that fornication, adulterers, and homosexuals shall not inherit the kingdom of God. I Corinthians 6:9-10 "Or do you not know that the unrig teous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals... shall inherit the kingdom of God." But you can change. That can be a thing of the past. The blood of Jesus washes all our sin away. See verse 11. "And such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God." Read II Corinthians 7 for advice on marriage, particularly verse 9 "But if they do not have self-control, let them marry; for it is better to marry than to burn."

If you are in a sexual relationship outside of marriage whether you are living together or not, then do whatever it takes to stop. (1) Either break off the relationship if you know you or the other person is not willing to commit to the other one and have a covenant relationship in marriage, (2) both should ask God for forgiveness and help to overcome further temptation and make a determination not to have sex until married or (3) pray, get the peace of God and make a commitment to each other and marry.

Remember your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit if Jesus is your Savior and Lord. Don't defile the temple. Sin is bad enough but with sex you cause someone else to sin. You do not want to cause others to sin and you certainly do not want to cause the one you say you love to sin. If he or she says that they love you they should not do anything to cause you to sin and mess up your relationship with your Heavenly Father.

Actually the Bible tells us in regards to immorality to run from it. *I Cor. 6:18 "Flee immorality..." and II Tim. 2:22 "Now flee from youthful lusts, and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart."* Other Scriptures on this are Romans 1:24-28, 32 (on homosexuality). I Cor. 4:17, I Cor. 6:15-20, II Cor. 6:14-18, Rev. 21:6-8, Rev. 22:14-15, Prov. 5:125; 6:23-35; 7:6-27.

Sex in or out of marriage is pleasurable to the flesh. But sex outside of marriage is like all sin; it is a passing pleasure and the results can be devastating. Of Moses this report comes - "choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God, than to enjoy the passing pleasure of sin." (see Heb. 11:25-26). He knew the reward of Christ was greater than the riches of the world in Egypt.

Is there any good news, anything good about sex? Yes, yes, yes. God designed it, He gave us the desire, He gives us emotions and love for another. He designed it so a husband and wife would replenish the earth with children, have a family unit and enjoy each other. He created it for - "special intimacy" between a man and a woman. It's your own special, private intimate thing to do together. It involves love, intimacy, trust, bonding as nothing else will do. In *Genesis 2:24 the Bible says, "they shall be one flesh." In Gen. 1:27 God created male and female and verse (28) says, "And God blessed them, and God said unto them, 'Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth,'..." And as for the enjoyment of each other read the book of Song of Solomon. It is filled with the fun and enjoyment of a man and woman in love. Let's look at a small portion here.*

Song of Solomon 1:13 (woman) "A bundle of myrrh is my beloved to me, that lies all night between my breasts." Song of Solomon 2:6 (woman) "His left hand is under my head, and his right hand embraces me." (10) My beloved spoke, and said, 'Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away." Song of Soloman 3:4 (woman) "...When I found the one I love. I held him and would not let him go, until I had brought him to the house of my mother, and into the chamber (room) of her who conceived me." Song of Solomon 4:1 (man) "...Behold you are fair my love! Behold, you are fair! You have dove's eyes...Your hair is like a flock of goats (2) Your teeth are like a flock of shorn sheep...up from the washing (3) Your lips are like a strand of scarlet, and your mouth is lovely (4) Your neck is like the tower of David...(5) Your two breasts are like two fawns (7) You are all fair, my love. And there is no spot in you. (9) You have ravished my heart, my sister, my spouse;... (10) How fair is your love." Song of Solomon 6:3 (woman) "I am my beloved's, and my beloved is mine ... " Song of Solomon 7:6-8 (man) "How fair and pleasant you are, O love, with your delights! (7) This stature of yours is like a palm tree, and your breasts like its clusters. (8) I said, "I will go up to the palm tree, I will take hold of its branches."

They compliment each other, they check out each others body thoroughly, they chase after each other, they have challenges, they overcome, they lie in bed, they become one.

Actually the Song of Solomon has a double meaning, one for the earthly relationship and the other for a heavenly relationship. It is about Jesus Christ and the church. Who will you arise and come away with? In a earthly sexual relationship it should be a husband and wife. In a heavenly eternal relationship it should be us with Jesus only. Song of Solomon says, "Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away;" one day we will rise up. Believers, followers and lovers of Jesus have this to look forward to - *I Thes. 4:16-18 "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet of God; and the dead in Christ shall rise first.*

TYSON DURFEY-2016 WORLD WHAT GOES IN YOU COMES OUT!

Tyson Durfey at his acceptance speech upon being the newly crowned 2016 World Champion Tiedown Calf Roper at the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas, Nevada gave the credit to his Savior Jesus Christ for always being there with him.

Two things that have gone into Tyson Durfey in life is roping and the Word of God. He is ready at a moments notice to talk about either or combine the two. It's what has brought him a successful life.

Tyson has been rop-Photo by James Phifer ing most all of his life, as soon as he could handle it. At age 4 he was riding with his dad, Roy Durfey. Some of his accomplishments are Missouri

High School Champion Tiedown Calf Roper in 2001 and 2002, the Canadian Professionals Rodeo Association championship three times-2006, 2008, and 2011. He won the calf roping at the first ever event known as "The American" in Dallas, Texas. It is a super large one day rodeo where the winner collects \$100,000, plus other go-round money. And Tyson has Qualified and roped at the WNFR 9 times. To top it all off, this year Tyson Durfey is the 2016 World Champion Tiedown Calf Roper. He has come a long way since roping with dad and his brothers as youngsters on the ranch at home.

A lot of "Roping Talk" and roping lessons have been put into Tyson. What goes in, comes out!. What came out is a class act tiedown calf roper who knows how to handle pressure situations and arise to win. The world title came down to Round 10, the final round at the WNWFR. Under that pressure arose a champion.

The Word of God is in Tyson also. What goes in, Comes



Out! The few times we have talked together if a subject arose, Tyson had a Scripture, a promise from God to handle it. Why? Because that is what he has put into himself and because he knows the Word of God is true and he can trust his heavenly Father.

Miracle Horse! That is what I would call Ranger, the horse he rode at the WNFR in the Grand Entry, who he had there as a backup roping horse as well. (The horse he competed on at the Finals is Nikko.) About three months before the 2016 WNFR Ranger reared and hit an object between his eyes. It crushed his skull. It took six cowboys to help Tyson stand his horse up. The first veterinarian said, "He is brain dead. We need to put him down." Tyson said, "Let's take him to another Vet. My God is bigger than that." The second Veterinarian said that the horse should be put down. He offered no hope for recovery. Tyson asked him, "Do we have a 50/50 chance." The Vet replied, "More like a 30% chance." Tyson responded by faith and said, "My God is bigger than that. I rodeo all year long on 30%." The rest of the story is the horse was healed well enough to be ridden at the WNFR and roped on as a backup horse if needed.

It was time to "fight the good fight of faith ... " (I Timothy 6:12) And live out Hebrews 11:1 "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." And 11:6 "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." As life changes Tyson relies on his Savior and Best Friend Jesus Christ to guide him and bring him through in good shape.

In October 2013 Tyson married Shea Fisher, a country western singer from Australia. She spent time in the USA as a young girl when her dad, Eddie Fisher, was in the PBR Bull Riding events. Her parents put the Word into Shea all of her life. As a young girl she was taught the Word of God at All Around Cowboy Church in Sealy, TX with Pastor Sonny and Gloria Rice. Shea opened the WNFR 9th Go Round with a country western song, and joined by others in the opening who were dancing on stage and in the arena.

And the couple has an added addition to the family. Their daughter, Praise Royal, was born this year on September the first. She attended her first WNFR this year at age three months. So continued on page 5

(17) Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and thus we shall always be with the Lord. 

ON THE TRAIL

Cherlyn and I were at the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas, Nevada for all 10 performances. I have attended NFR Rodeos for about 30 years. I did the Power Up the last two perfs with the contestants in the warm-up tent before the Grand Entry. Power Up is a short word from the Word (3-4 minutes) and a prayer just before competition time. Coy Huffman began these over 30 years ago. He gave the Power Up Word the first eight perfs. It's always a pleasure to be with Coy. He is one of the first full time apostles/cowboy preachers on the rodeo trail. To the best of my memory he was the second or third full time Cowboy Preacher on the rodeo trail.

We were into one on one ministry everyday at the various Cowboy Christmas Trade Shows, the Miniature Bareback and Bull Ridings, the Casinos and Hotels, on the streets, in a skin care store with a young Jewish man, in the Gold Card Room at the WNFR, and at the WNFR Rodeo. It was a busy time presenting Jesus all along the way from Texas to Nevada and back. We drove it this time; it was about 1245 miles one way. We drove 22 hours non-stop going and 21 hours non-stop coming home. I had car lag (not jet lag.) But I recuperated in a couple of days and here I sit typing this On The Trail report. We passed out hundreds of Christian Cowboys and Friends Magazines. There is a Prayer to receive Jesus as Savior and Lord in each one, plus teachings to make disciples, and good testimonies of Christian rodeo cowboys.

Dodie Osteen, who was co-founder of the well known Lakewood Church in Houston, Texas, gave me a note and a verse when I spoke there 23 years ago which I still keep in my bank bag to this day. It is from the Living Bible which I rarely use. The note and the verse said, "Ronnie, You blessed us. We are so glad for all you do for Jesus.Psalm 56:9 "The day that we pray, the tide of the battle turns." I told the contestants it was time for the tide of their battle to turn. I shared that verse with several contestants who were struggling some at the rodeo. Two won the next go-round in their event. Three others placed after a few rough nights with not so good performances. My wife and I smiled and laughed as we enjoyed them taking the word of encouragement and turning their battle from defeat to victory. Take hold of God's plans and ideas and promises and the tide of your battle will turn also.

I write this at 'Merry Christmas" time. The New Year 2017





We will be On The Trail again in 2017 sharing the love of God




